MEELTTINNGG

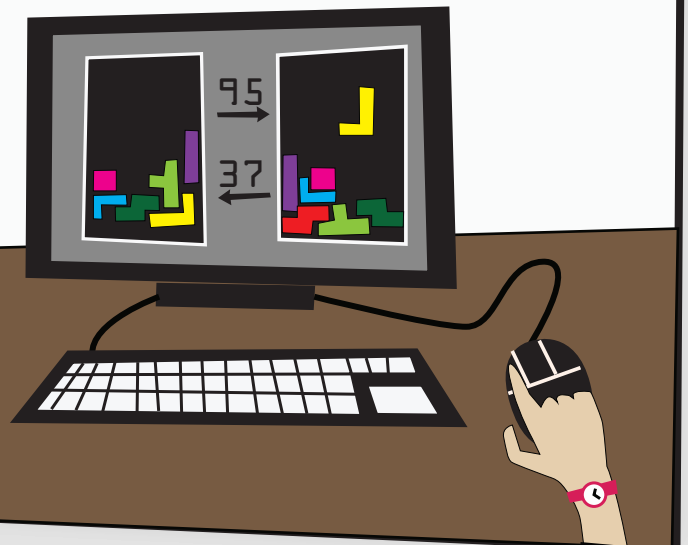
Draw something melting into a puddle of goo. Use your whole paper and be as creative as you want!



SURFING THE WEB

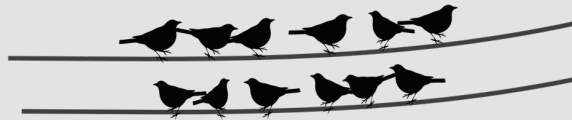
Imagine you are using your computer - look down at your desk and draw what you see.
